### Your help is needed to save endangered orangutans

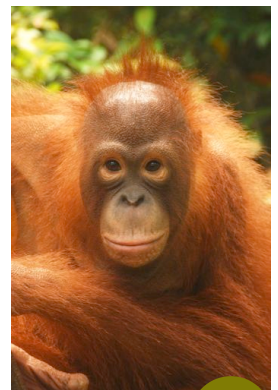
Orangutan Foundation International (OFI) is reaching out to students across the globe in a monumental effort to keep the world's last remaining orangutans from going extinct.

To protect the park, and thousands of acres of tropical rainforest that surround it, from illegal logging, mining, hunting, and palm oil agriculture, **OFI patrols the forest night and day, 365 days per year.** Our round-the-clock patrols have saved the lives of countless orangutans and other wildlife species.

**But these patrols cost lots of money—\$560 per day!** Costs include maintaining police officers and OFI rangers in guard posts and on chartered boats, along with food, salaries, boat drivers, fuel, equipment, administration, and supplies.

**Your support is urgently needed.** OFI is asking school and civic groups, boys' and
