**EVERY DAY** Borneo's beautiful rainforests are being cut down, leaving many orangutans homeless. Mother orangutans are often killed and their babies are captured and sold as pets. Many orphaned orangutans are rescued by OFI and brought to our Orangutan Care Center.

Most orphans come to our Care Center injured, hungry and scared. Here they receive medical care, food, love, and training to prepare them for their release back into the wild. Orphaned babies need our special help until they are eight years old.

**CARING FOR** more than 340 orangutans in our Care Center is an expensive, round-the-clock effort, requiring lots of food, medical supplies, and special equipment. Every day our orangutan helpers take the orphans out into the forest where they are free to play while learning how to survive in the wild.
